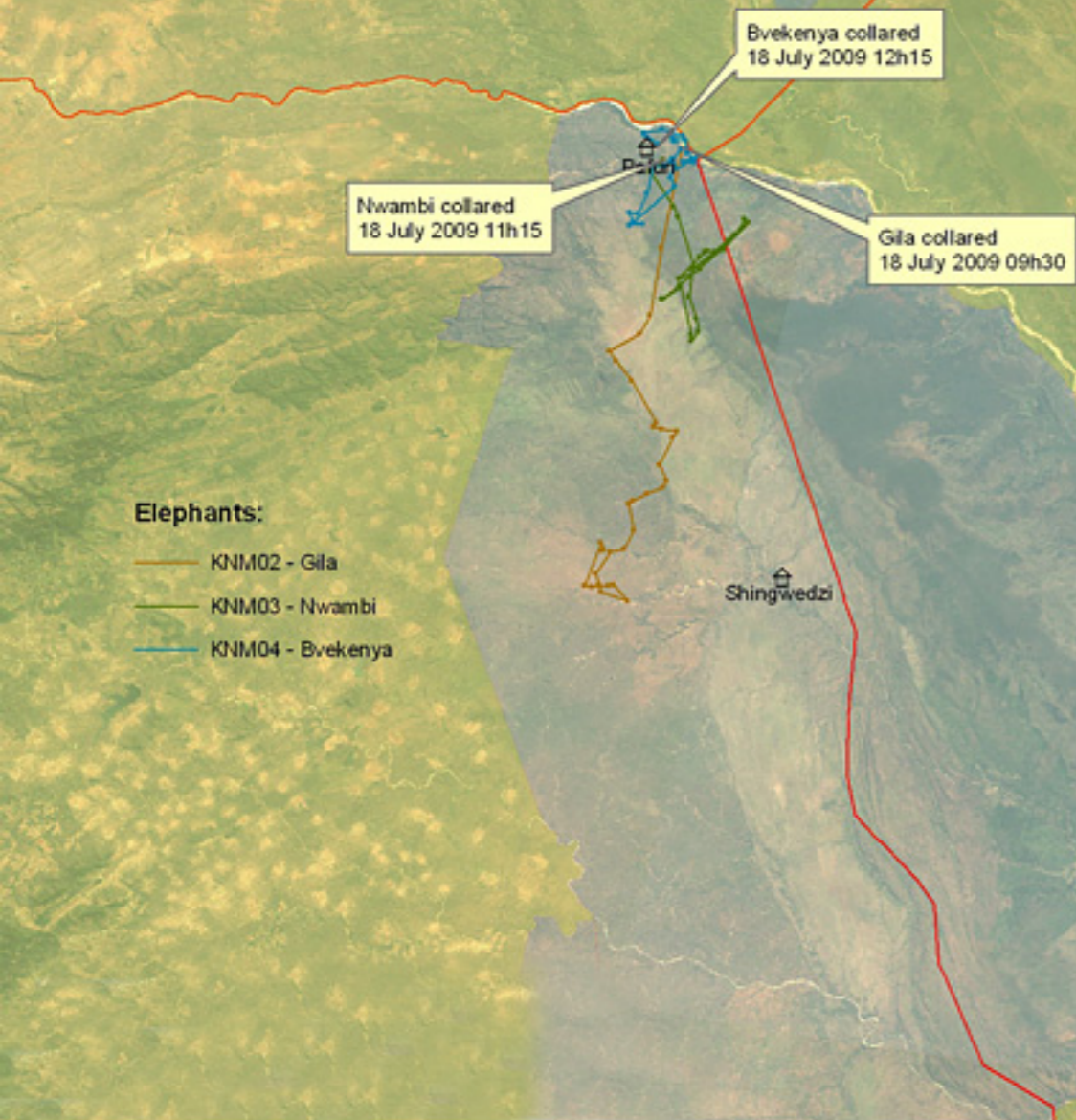
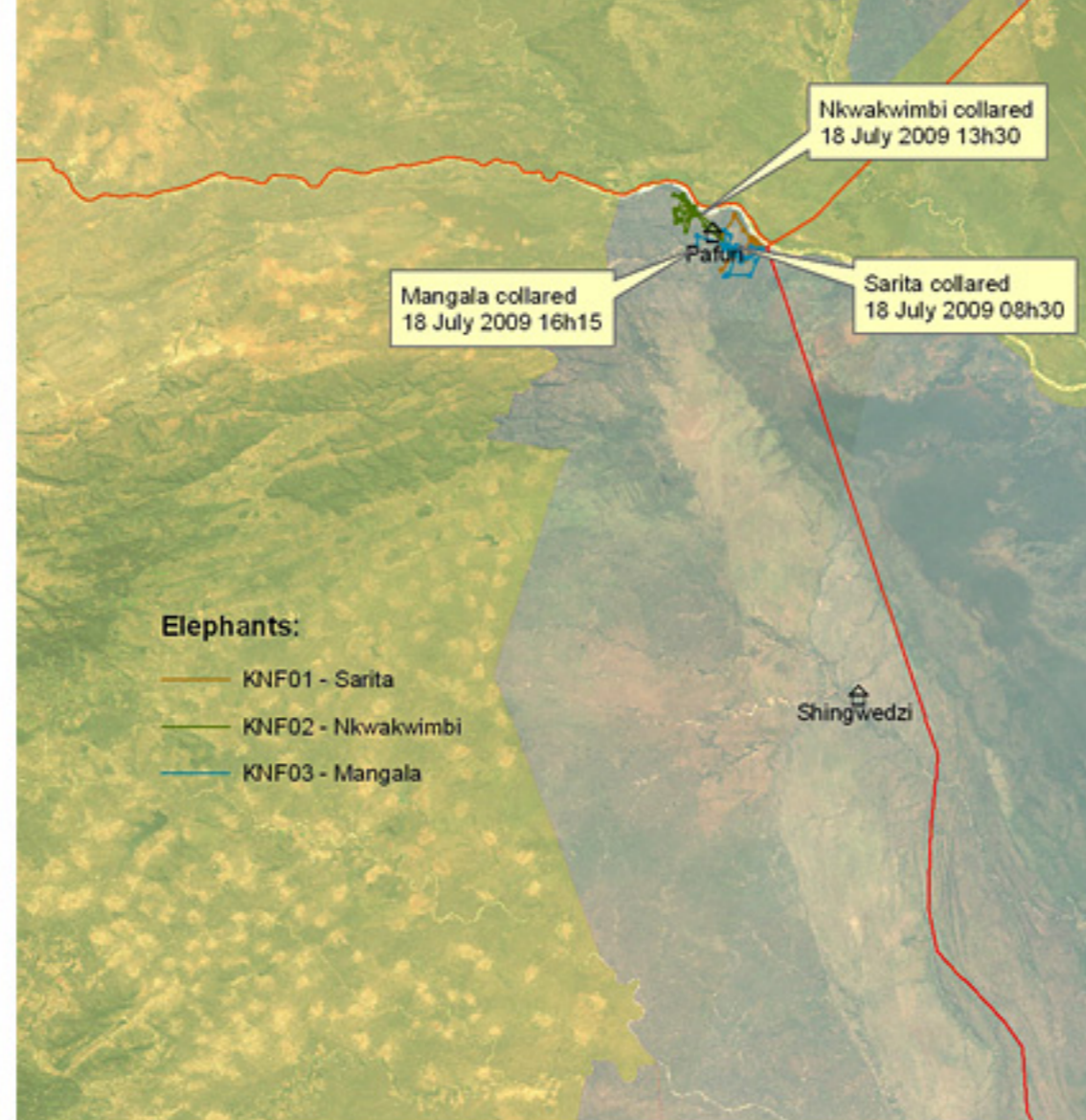


July 2009: Three bulls, all adults, were added to the study population. This brings the number of elephants tagged with GPS collars in the Pafuri region up to seven (one immature bull collared last year, three adult bulls and three cows this year). One of the bulls, Bvekenya, was originally identified in this area by Wilderness Safari guides in September 2008.



July 2009: Three adult cows were collared this month. The first two, Sarita and Nkwakwimbi, were found as lone adult cows with their offspring. The third, Mangala, was part of a larger herd of approximately 20 animals.



July 2009: Mapimbi continues to move between the sandveld vegetation in the north-east and the area west of Shingwedzi.
